# Clustering - What is It and How to Do It

**Clustering is** a technique used to compare your DNA matches to each other. This method groups your matches into clusters based on *shared DNA segments*.

- The groups or clusters assist in identifying individual ancestors or ancestor pairs.
- Especially helpful for Ancestry where there is no chromosome browser
- Helps with matches who don't answer and don't have trees
- · Can help focus your research
